Diabetes and oral health

- Broken jaw or severe injury to the face or teeth
- Swelling of the face, throat or mouth with any of the following:
 - o Trouble breathing or swallowing
 - o Fever of 100 $^{\circ}$ F or higher
- Severe pain with or without swelling
- Bleeding in the mouth that won't stop

If none of the items apply to your child, call a dentist or consider the closest urgent care center. Only you can decide what's best for your child, but always follow up with a visit to the dentist after urgent or emergency care.
