Chew On This



Nationally, between 41–55% of kids ages 2–11 suffer from tooth decay; 34% untreated



Nearly half of all kids entering kindergarten have at least one cavity



70% of UP third-graders have a history of tooth decay



More than 25% of Michigan third-graders have untreated dental disease





Chew On This

Good oral health is connected to school success

- Tooth decay is the most common chronic childhood disease in the U.S.
- 51 million hours of missed school yearly
- Absent students miss critical instruction time
- Students who don't read at grade level are more likely to drop out
- Students who have had recent oral health pain are four times more likely to have lower GPAs



A Call for Action

- Access to dental care for Michigan's young Medicaid beneficiaries has been a longtime chronic problem
 - Dentists are reluctant to participate
 - Low reimbursement rates
 - Administrative hassles
- Creates barriers that prevent children from accessing good dental care



Creating Solutions

- Michigan addressed this issue using a Dental Task
 Force to assess the problem and propose solutions
 - Task force recommended children's dental care system function similarly to commercial dental insurance
- In 1998 and 1999, Michigan legislature appropriated \$10.9M for oral health initiatives
 - \$5.9M building effort for oral health clinics
 - \$5M demonstration program to increase private dentists' participation, called Healthy Kids Dental (HKD)



Healthy Kids Dental (HKD)

- Contracted by the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS)
 - Administered by Delta Dental of Michigan and Blue Cross Blue Shield
- Project initiated May 1, 2000, in 22 counties
 - October 1, 2000, expanded additional 15 counties
 - October 2015, HKD expanded to all 83 counties in Michigan!
 - In 2016, Michigan expanded the age range to include children ages 13-20 for Wayne, Oakland and Kent counties.



Healthy Kids Dental

- No copays/deductibles
- Dental benefits for nearly 1 million children
 - -Medicaid enrollees
 - -Under age 21
- Options for benefit administration
 - -Delta Dental
 - Blue Cross Blue Shield (DentaQuest)
- Enrollee assignment with option to switch
 - -5:1 ration



What Makes HKD an Effective Solution?

- ✓ Increased reimbursement rates for participating providers
- ✓ Claims submission process is identical to claims submission process for Delta Dental's commercial business
- ✓ Member ID cards are identical to private subscriber cards
- ✓ Enrollees are treated as privately insured patients



Delta Dental Partners

Currently, about 8 out of 10 Michigan dentists participate with Delta Dental HKD

ADA named HKD **1 of 5** national program models for improving access to care for low-income populations

What's Covered?

- Oral exams

- Re-cementing of crowns,bridges and space maintainers
- Root canals
- Extractions
- Complete, partial and temporary partial dentures
- Denture adjustments and repairs
- Denture rebases and relines
- Emergency treatment to reduce pain
- IV sedation (when needed)

American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry

- First visit—before age 1
- Fluoride varnish—once first teeth appear
- Dental cleaning—age 2, twice yearly
- X-rays—age 2
- Sealants—ages 6 and 12

HKD, administered in part by Delta Dental, helps children with Medicaid have healthy, happy smiles.
